## CONTRACT

The following is an AGREEMENT required by the state of Oklahoma to insure students that Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle has fully disclosed all costs associated with the motorcycle safety course.

The Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle program offers motorcycle safety training courses that meet all Motorcycle Safety Foundation standards. Courses include classroom activities and riding exercises. The BRC and 3-wheel courses are fifteen hours of training. The BRC2 course is 7 hours. Breaks and meal time are not included as training time. All instructors maintain certification through the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, and all curriculum and materials are approved by the State of Oklahoma.

Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle provides to the student, property owners, instructors, and others with involved interest an insurance policy through the Motorcycle Safety Foundation that provides for liability, training bike damage, and medical and dental coverage. This coverage is included in the course fee.

All written material and training aids are included in the cost of the course. All audio-visual materials are the property of Brown's Driving Schools - Motorcycle. Instructors may take group pictures at no additional charge.

The Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle maintains a fleet of training bikes for use in the BRC and 3WBRC courses. All maintenance, fuel, and lubricants for these bikes is provided by Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle.

Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle maintains an inventory of loaner gloves and helmets at no cost to the student. Students are encouraged to provide their own riding equipment: The required riding equipment is: long sleeve shirt or jacket, long pants, eye protection, over the ankle footwear, full fingered gloves, helmet. No student or instructor will be allowed to ride any portion of the course without all of these items.

A written and riding test will be administered during the course. Motorcycle Safety Foundation completion cards will be given to those students who meet the minimum standards set by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation. No fee is charged for the completion certificates.

On the range Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle will provide drinking water; however, soft drinks, snacks and lunch are not provided.

Students will not be solicited by any Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle representative for any fees other than the original course fee. Any improper solicitation should be reported to Brown's Driving School - Motorcycle at 405-692-4844.
